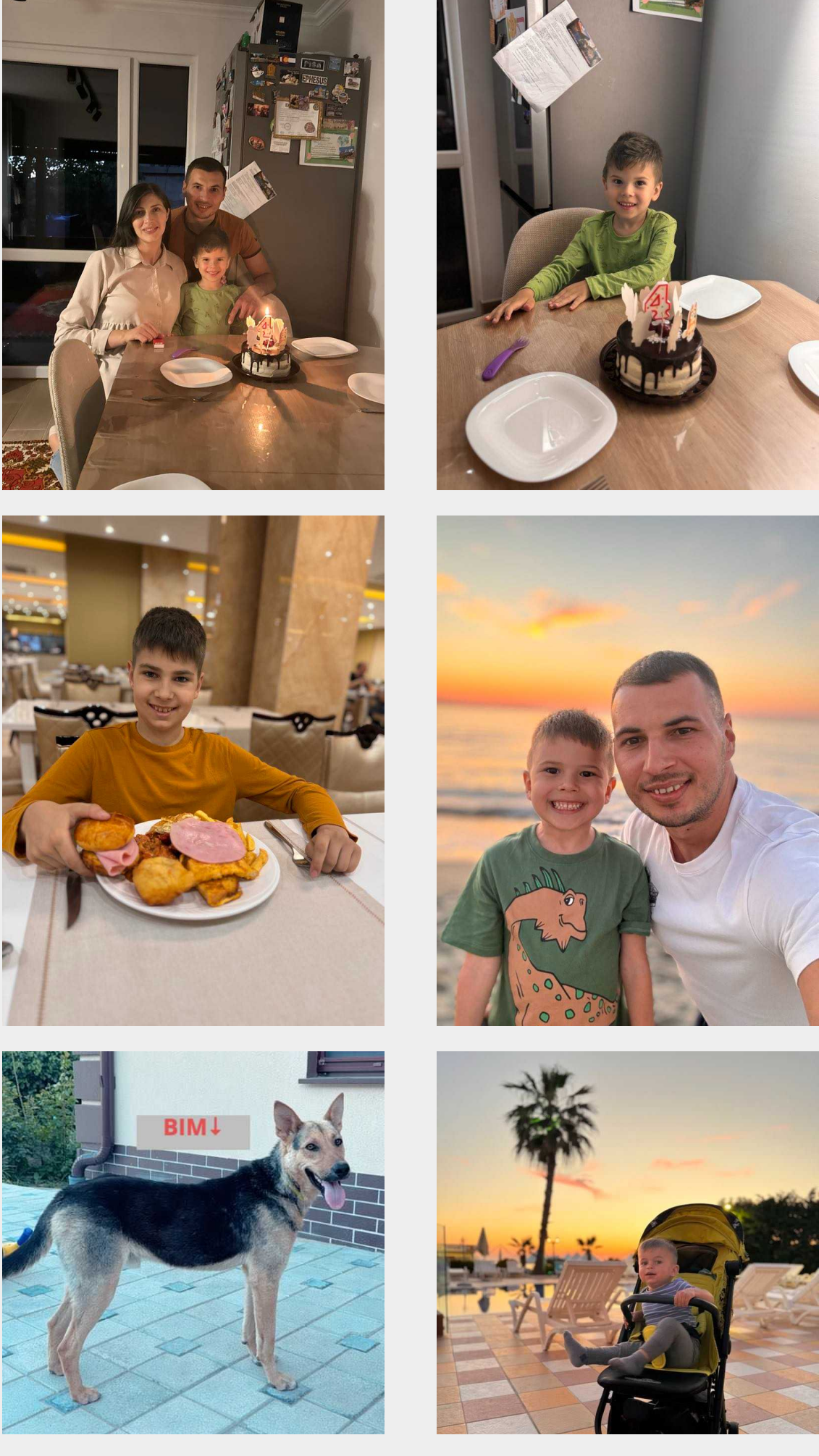


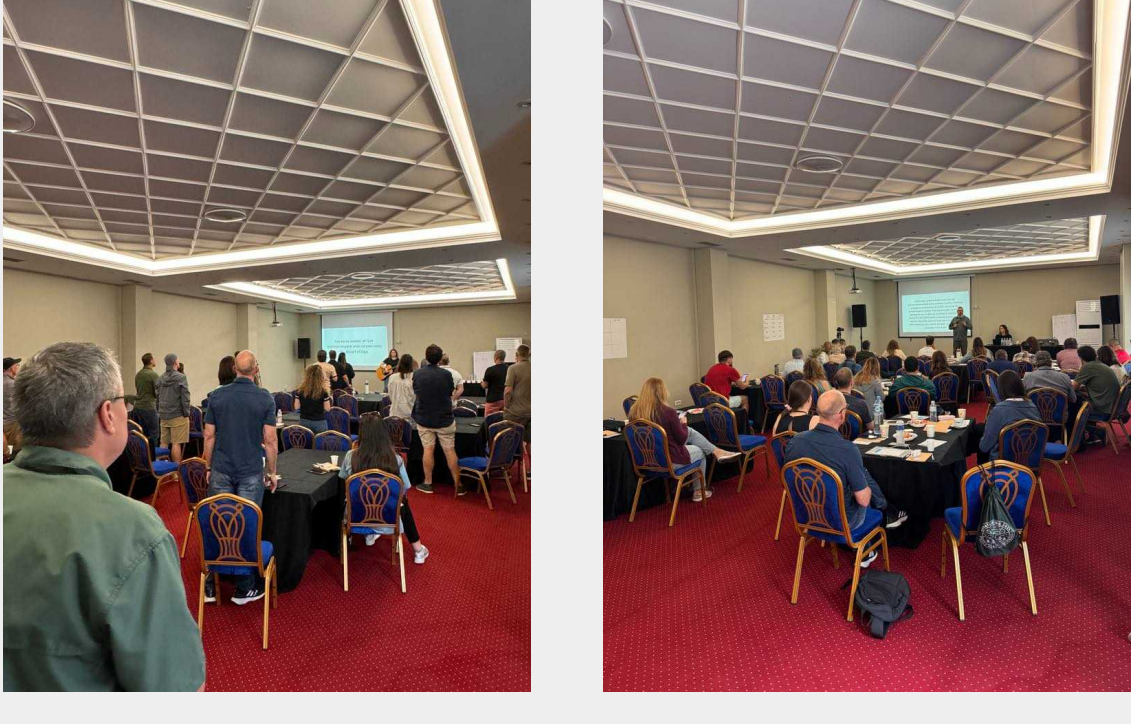


Hello our dear friend!

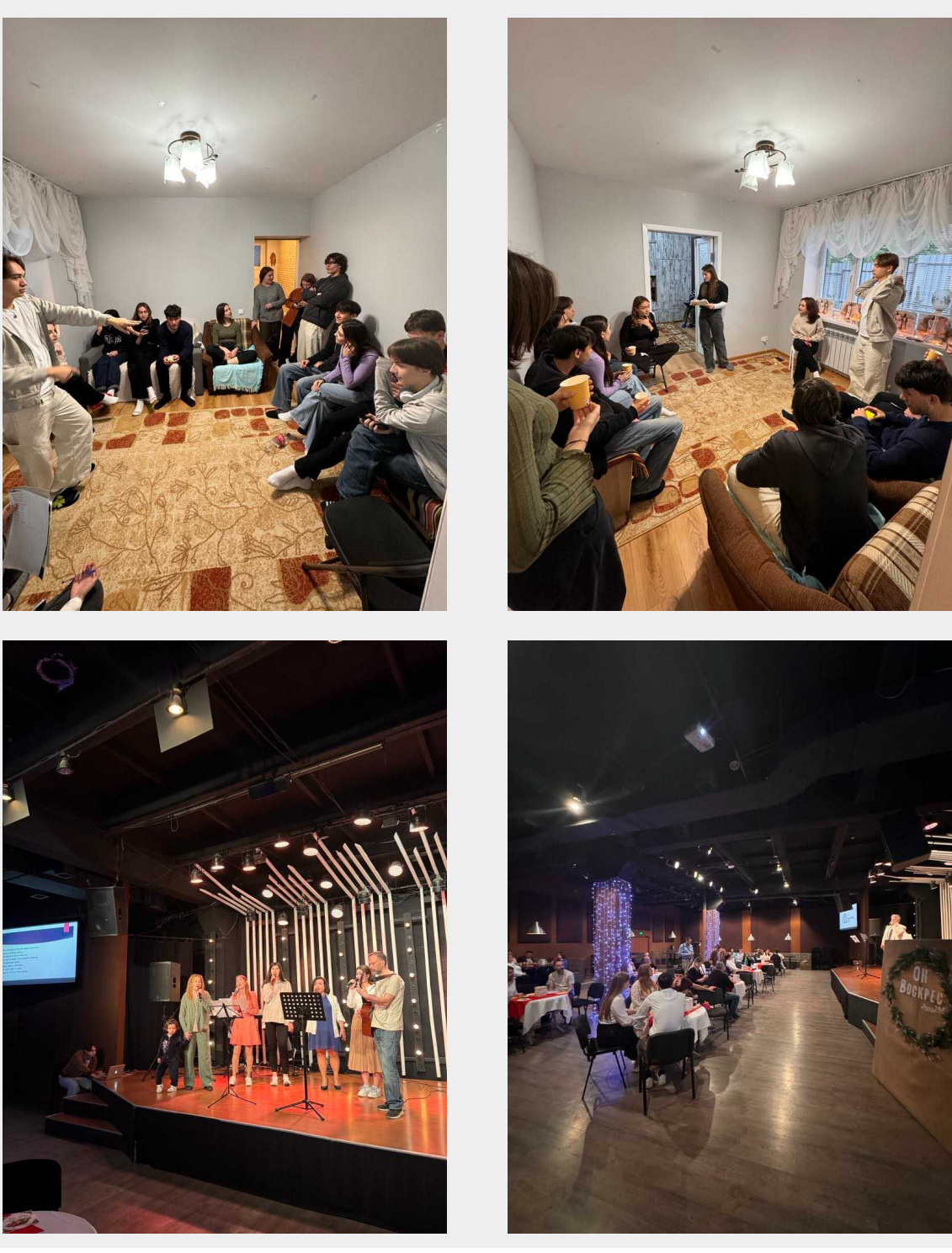


Another event: was the Bible reading before Easter. It was a full-scale project throughout our city. About 35 churches participated in partnership in this project. The gospel was shared with over 40,000 people.
Two new people from this project joined our church at Easter, and it is a great encouragement to us that the Lord continues to add new saved people and increase His kingdom. It was a very interesting experience: we just read the Gospel of John in central parks and places where there were a lot of people, and people would stop and listen and ask us questions about what we were doing here and why we were doing it, which was very blessed for us that they were interested in the Gospel and looking for answers to their questions. What made our conversations neutral and completely open with each other.
We sincerely appreciate that, despite all the chaos and the outbreak of war in Ukraine, in addition to the difficult news and crisis, our churches have become more open to cooperation with each other and the joint expansion of the Kingdom of God.

Another event: Also, as you may recall, our young ministry continues with the youth, and we were able to celebrate the Easter holiday together by reflecting on how the Lord Jesus Christ lived on this earth, died, and Risen, so that everyone who believes in Him may have eternal life.
A day later, we were able to gather with our network of home Churches and celebrate in Christ's resurrection. We are grateful to the Lord that He saved us, by faith in Him, not by our works, as the Bible says, it is something special to remember his resurrection and how merciful and loving our God is .

Prayer request for our family: Unfortunately, this year, in addition to many evangelistic projects and the celebration of Easter, since we celebrate the old calendar in the Orthodox style. This year has been more difficult than any other in our lives, right before Easter my uncle died. The last of the older men of the Juicov generation. He died suddenly of a massive stroke as diagnosed by doctors, but after an autopsy it turned out that he had a microstroke, and the cause of death was a hematoma from a large blow between his spine and head, which paralyzed half his body and then led to his death.
Immediately after this diagnosis, forensic science and the police got involved and began to investigate this case, as there was a suspicion of murder. This last week in our lives has been very difficult. And despite the fact that we were really looking for joy in the weeks of Easter, it was very difficult, since all this news accompanied us.
Forensics put the conclusion after an investigation and a lot of questioning: that the uncle felt ill after a microstroke and wanted to take his medicine, but tripped over the carpet and fell unluckily with his neck into the corner of a small table, which led him to this situation
With God's help the body was freed from the police and last Friday, we were able to complete the funeral.
Please pray for our entire family, and our loved ones and relatives, we are all very shocked, it's really not easy.
