A Call to Compassion

We want to share the story of a dear family member, Aunt Eugenia, her name is also Eugenia.

Having left the war-torn Donbass region of Ukraine, she has been living with us since this fall, seeking refuge and healing after the enormous hardships, sounds of bomb explosions and tragedy she witnessed there. If you remember a year ago, we told her testimony when she believed on the Feasts of Hope. When Wil Graham came to Moldova. After that feast, she came home to Ukraine, but beginning late this summer of 2024, there has been tremendous fighting in that region, and it is now the most militarily active region in Ukraine. We have long persuaded her to come to us, but she was still hesitant to leave her family and husband there. At the beginning of this fall, the state of Ukraine, due to the terrible fighting that is taking place there, began to evacuate all the inhabitants of this region, and the village where my aunt lived was obliged to evacuate, so she is now in Moldova.

Through it all, her faith has remained steadfast, a beautiful testament to God's sustaining grace.

We are committed to meeting her physical, emotional, and spiritual needs during this critical time.
